## Choir Corner

Today's one anthem – "Draw Us In the Spirit's Tether" was written by Harold W. Friedell. It has become a church choir standard. Friedell is somewhat of a "local" having been born (1905) in Jamaica, Queens. He spent most of his life in the Metropolitan NYC area. He studied organ and composition at Julliard, and later taught there. He was organist and choirmaster at a number of NYC churches; his last post having been at St. Bartholomew's on Park Avenue. He composed this morning's anthem in 1957. The following February, he died of a heart attack while walking to the train station in Hastings-on-Hudson following a heavy snow storm. He is buried at Sleepy Hollow Cemetery in Tarrytown, NY.

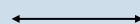
